## MISSION CO-OP SUNDAY

Once a year, on Mission Co-op Sunday, we welcome a missionary from another country in order to have the opportunity to learn about and to respond to particular needs of a region. Last Sunday we welcomed FATHER ANAND ISUKALA, a priest of the Diocese of Cuddapah in Southern India. He was here to help us become more aware of those in need in countries around the world. India is one third the size of the United States; and there are three times as many people in India with 75% of them being Hindus, 18% Muslim and 7% Christians.

The Diocese of Cuddapah has 85,000 Catholics spread out in 56 parishes served by 160 priests.

The majority of Catholics belong to lower castes. The caste system is very powerful in India even today. Low caste Catholics have been suppressed politically, socially, educationally and economically by the upper caste people. In the secular society, Catholics are also treated as untouchables by the other castes.

The Church in India is committed to improve the living standards of low caste poor Catholics whose lives had been shattered by the deadly Tsunami and by recent persecutions and attacks on Christians in India.

The donations collected are directly used to reconstruct peoples' lives in Christ by helping to build village chapels for prayer, helping to educate orphans, as well as caring for the physically and mentally challenged, and for the many street children of India. The empowerment of Catholic men and women in being able to minister in these areas is a special focus of parish training.

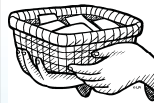
