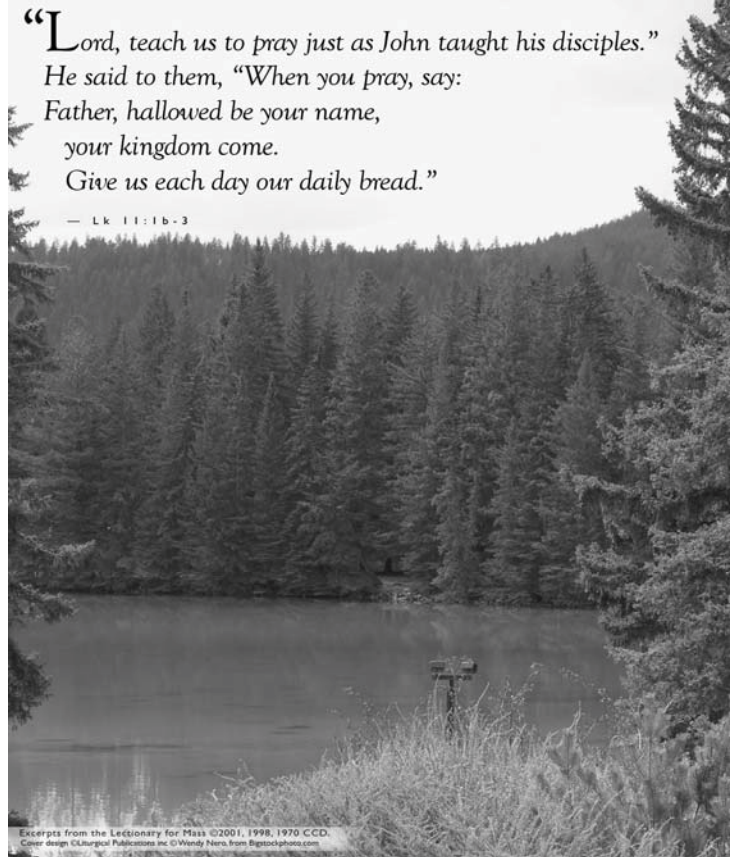

OUR TARGET DATE FOR CHANGE!

Many of you have probably heard of the changes coming to THE WORDS USED IN OUR ENGLISH TRANSLATION in our celebration of Mass—our Liturgy of the Word and Eucharist. Between now and then, brief explanations about “why”, “what”, and “how” this will happen will be printed in our bulletin; and Fr. Roger will also begin more detailed explanations as part of our reflections during Sunday Mass.

To begin with,

WHY IS THERE A NEED FOR A NEW TRANSLATION?

Pope John Paul II issued a third edition of our Missal (the official text of prayers for Mass) during the Jubilee Year in 2000. This edition included many new texts requiring translation from the original Latin. Since then, the experience of the years since the Second Vatican Council (when nearly all Latin prayers were translated in English, and in the languages of peoples of every other country) has now given rise to more formal and more adequate literal translations of the original Latin texts.

This new translation will employ the best of what we have learned about translation and liturgical language after two generations of celebrating the Liturgy in English. The new English translation is meant to capture more adequately a fuller meaning, and hopefully a deeper understanding, of the core areas of our Faith. This revised translation will also provide an opportunity for all of us to reflect ever more deeply on the Eucharistic celebration that lies at the heart of the Church’s Life and Faith.

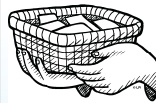
