### SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

#### BAPTISMAL INFORMATION

Our preparation class for prospective parents and godparents is held the first Sunday of Jan., April, July and Oct. at 11:00am at the Church in Minturn. Class is required if you have not taken one in the last three years. At least one godparent must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. You must be a registered parishioner. If not, a letter from their parish priest is required, verifying they are members in good standing. Our class focuses on the meaning of the sacrament of Baptism and the responsibilities of parents and godparents. **You must pre-register**, at St. Patrick's office at 477-0378 x12. **Communal Baptism is celebrated on the 3rd Sunday of the months listed above.**

**RECONCILIATION** is available 15 minutes before each weekend Mass.

**MARRIAGE** Engaged couples must contact the Vail Parish Office at least eight months in advance of planned wedding.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK** The hospital is no longer allowed to give names of Catholic patients in the hospital. Please let Father know at Mass on Saturday or Sunday before you enter the hospital, so he can plan to anoint you with the Sacrament of the Sick, extend the Eucharist and have a visit. ## WELCOME FR. ROGER LASCELLE

Thank you to all who have so warmly welcomed me to our parishes of Minturn, Vail and Red Cliff. As I mentioned this past weekend, our transition will take some time until you and I become more comfortable with each other. I hope that this brief biography will help by your knowing more about me.

My father Roger was born in French Canada, and my mother Frances is of Irish descent. I was born on November 27, 1947 in Concord, New Hampshire, and grew up speaking both French and English. In my early 20's I became a member of a Religious teaching order (Brothers of the Sacred Heart) in New England. My college years were with the Jesuits at Spring Hill College in Mobile, Alabama; and as a Religious Brother, I taught Algebra and Religion in High School for 4 years.

In 1973 I left the Brothers and attended Saint Mary Seminary and University in Baltimore, Maryland. My ordination to Priesthood occurred in Worcester, Massachusetts on June 18, 1977. After serving as a priest for 10 years in Worcester, I moved to Colorado where, at that time, there was a greater need for priest help.

My first assignment was at Light of the World Church in Littleton, Colorado; after which I served at Holy Name Church in Steamboat Springs. For 13 years I was the pastor in Meeker, Rangely, and Craig, Colorado; and during the last 6 years I have been pastor of Saint Joseph Church and School in Old Town Fort Collins.

Having now been ordained for 33 years, I am very happy to be with you as we continue together our growth in Faith of the Lord Jesus, and as we witness that Faith through our Catholic parish communities.

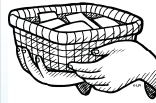
